



USING POTABLE WATER AT SEAVIEW MARINA

We are pleased to provide convenient access to clean, potable water at all our berths. This guide will help you make the best use of our water facilities during your stay.

ACCESSING POTABLE WATER



Location of Taps

Each berth is fitted with a water tap usually positioned on the power pedestal



Connecting Your Hose

Please use a food-grade hose to protect water quality. Ensure connections are tight to avoid leaks and use a trigger nozzle to conserve water

USAGE GUIDELINES



Conserve Water

Use water efficiently and avoid wastage to help protect our environment



Hose Maintenance

Disconnect your hose after use to prevent damage and reduce trip hazards along the pontoons



Report Leaks

Notify the Marina Office immediately if you notice any leaks or issues with taps

HEALTH AND SAFETY



Regular Testing

Our potable water supply is tested regularly to meet health and safety standards



Hygiene

Wash your hands after handling hoses and taps to maintain personal hygiene

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS



Avoid Contamination

Do not use hoses to rinse off harmful chemicals or pollutants in the harbour



Spill Response

In case of any spills, notify Marina Staff right away to initiate proper cleanup procedures
